A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, ON BEHALF OF WICOMICO COUNTY, TO EXECUTE A FORM TITLED "AUTHORIZATION TO WRITE-OFF UNCOLLECTIBLE TAXES" FOR UNPAID STATE PROPERTY TAXES ON 700 ROSE STREET, SALISBURY, MARYLAND (TAX ACCOUNT NO. 09-017313).

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Annotated Code of Maryland, Tax Property Article, Title 4-401, the collector of state taxes is authorized to write-off unpaid taxes for property acquired by the County using the "Authorization to Write-Off Uncollectible Taxes" form; and

WHEREAS, write-offs of state taxes are to be certified by the local governing body and the collector of State taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Charter, Section 505, designates the Director of Finance as the collector of State taxes in the County; and

WHEREAS, Wicomico County, Maryland acquired 700 Rose Street, Salisbury Maryland, by Deed dated October 29, 2012 and recorded among the Land Records of Wicomico County in Liber 3503, Folio 432; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Director of Finance recommend all State property taxes be written off on 700 Rose Street, Salisbury, Maryland (Tax Account No. 09-017313).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the County Executive is authorized to execute the "Authorization to Write-off Uncollectible Taxes," in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, for unpaid State property taxes on 700 Rose Street, Salisbury, Maryland (Tax Account No. 09-017313).
