Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000.00) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR A COMMUNITY OUTREACH ADDICTION TEAM.

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies; and

WHEREAS, Wicomico County is facing an impending crisis regarding the current opioid addiction epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Health Department has partnered with the State's Attorney's Office, Sheriff's Department and Salisbury Police Department to form a Community Outreach Addiction Team, which will work together to proactively respond to local community areas experiencing clusters of drug overdose and addiction issues, in order to enhance linkage and bridging with appropriate treatment and support services; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Health Department has requested funding in the amount of \$30,000.00 to pay for said program; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.




