A RESOLUTION TO DEDICATE THE WETIPQUIN BRIDGE TO EDWARD THEODORE TAYLOR

WHEREAS, Mr. Edward Theodore Taylor was born in the rural village of Wetipquin located in Wicomico County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor has played a lifelong role in improving the community of his birth; and

WHEREAS, Edward Theodore Taylor served on the Wicomico County Council for 12 years as the District 1 representative; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor, understanding the impact a potential closure of a deteriorated bridge would have on the residents and businesses in the community, led support for funding to replace the Wetipquin Bridge at a cost of \$2.1 million dollars with 80% federal funding and 20% county funding; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and County Executive recognize and appreciate the devotion and persistent efforts of Edward Theodore Taylor toward gaining approval by the Wicomico County Council for the construction of the new Wetipquin Bridge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the Wetipquin Bridge shall be dedicated to Edward Theodore Taylor and a permanent plaque be mounted on the Wetipquin Bridge in his honor.
