A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 12' WIDE STORM DRAINAGE EASEMENT EXTENDING FROM SOUTH DIVISION STREET TO WAYNE STREET AS ABANDONED AND TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO RELEASE THE STORM DRAINAGE EASEMENT IN THE WICOMICO COUNTY LAND RECORDS.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has received a request to close a 12' wide storm drainage easement extending from South Division Street to Wayne Street; and

WHEREAS, the 12' wide storm drainage easement was established in 1957 to direct runoff from South Division Street; and

WHEREAS, the property that contains the easement was annexed by the City of Salisbury and acquired by Salisbury University for use as athletic fields; and

WHEREAS, Salisbury University, in 2006, improved its stadium facility and rerouted the storm drainage system along Wayne Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the 12' wide storm drainage easement extending across Salisbury University's athletic fields, in an easterly direction from South Division Street to Wayne Street, is no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

- 1. The 12' wide storm drainage easement, extending in an easterly direction from South Division Street to Wayne Street, is hereby declared abandoned.
2. The County Executive is authorized to release the 12' wide storm drainage easement extending in an easterly direction from South Division Street to Wayne Street in the Wicomico County Land Records.
