A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACQUIRE 1.5 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED ON THE EASTERLY SIDE OF SNOW HILL ROAD, KNOWN AS 333 SNOW HILL ROAD, TAX MAP 112, PARCEL 1805, FOR THE USE OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS AS OFFICE SPACE AND FOR THE STORAGE OF VOTING MACHINES AND ELECTION EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22-1 of Chapter 22, entitled "County-owned property" paragraph A, the County Executive is authorized, on behalf of and in the name of Wicomico County, Maryland, to acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, gift or condemnation for public purpose any real property or interest therein in the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive desires to purchase 1.5 acres of land, more or less, located on the easterly side of Snow Hill Road, known as 333 Snow Hill Road, Salisbury, MD, for the use of the Board of Elections as office space and for the storage of voting machines and election equipment; and

WHEREAS, Linda Shinn and Sara Shinn have agreed to sell said real property known as 333 Snow Hill Road, Salisbury, MD for the purchase price of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to acquire 1.5 acres of land, more or less, located on the easterly side of Snow Hill Road, known as 333 Snow Hill Road, Salisbury, MD, (Tax Map 112, Parcel 1805), at the purchase price of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), for the use of the Board of Elections as office space and for the storage of voting machines and election equipment.
