A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT, STATEWIDE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDREN FIFTY DOLLARS (\$12,750).

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of the Environment solicited grant applications under the Statewide Electronics Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, desires to recycle computers and other electronic goods in order to save valuable landfill capacity, recycle useful materials, and protect public health and the environment from the potential effects of metals and chemicals that may leach from electronics; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, completed a grant application under the Statewide Electronics Recycling Program and has been awarded a grant in the amount of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,750); and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant award from the Maryland Department of the Environment, Statewide Electronics Recycling Program, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,750).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Maryland Department of the Environment, Statewide Electronics Recycling Program, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,750).
