Resolution No. 106-2016

Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE THE WICOMICO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AS THE "PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT" FOR RECEIPT OF CERTAIN JUNK AND SCRAP METAL REPORTS IN THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, Section 17-1011, requires a junk dealer or scrap metal processor to keep an accurate record of the purchase of junk or scrap metal; and

WHEREAS, Section 17-1011 further requires a junk dealer or scrap metal processor to submit electronically a copy of each record of the purchase of junk or scrap metal to the "primary law enforcement unit" of the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held; and

WHEREAS, the Business Regulations Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Section 17-1001, defines a "primary law enforcement unit" as "a police department ... as designated by resolution of the county ... governing body in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held"; and

WHEREAS, the Business Regulations Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Section 17-1003, requires "(a) county ... governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held (to) designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records" of the purchase of junk or scrap metal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office is hereby designated as the "primary law enforcement unit" for Wicomico County for the purpose of receiving records of the purchase of junk or scrap metal by a junk dealer or scrap metal processor whose license is held in Wicomico County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its enactment.




