Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FROM CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTY-NINE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$79,633.52).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Electronic Courts Program (MDEC) is a single judiciary-wide integrated case management system that will collect, store and process records electronically; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Eastern Shore counties (Wicomico, Worcester, Dorchester and Somerset) will be required to use the statewide MDEC program starting in December 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County State's Attorney's Office has requested funding in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$72,400.00) for the purchase, installation, training and maintenance of the MDEC program and Seven Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Two Cents (\$7,233.52) to purchase a server to house the MDEC program; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.
