A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE OPPORTUNITY COMPACT GRANT AWARD FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.

WHEREAS, the Opportunity Compact provides one-time financial investments to seed effective strategies that improve lives for individuals who would otherwise have to be served by a costly program, such as foster care, juvenile detention or prison; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office for Children has approved and awarded the Wicomico Partnership for Families and Children an Opportunity Compact grant in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000); and

WHEREAS, the County Council, on July 7, 2015, adopted Resolution No. 101-2015 authorizing the acceptance and appropriation of the Opportunity Compact grant funds to be used to implement an Opportunity Compact centered on youth involved in the adjudication process with the Department of Juvenile Services in Wicomico County; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Partnership for Families and Children now desires to modify the Opportunity Compact Grant to use the grant funds for the Wicomico County Teen Court; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office for Children has approved the grant modification request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the request to amend the Opportunity Compact Grant Award, in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), to use the grant funds for the Wicomico County Teen Court, is hereby approved.
