A RESOLUTION TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION, PARKS & TOURISM FROM UNANTICIPATED REVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$10,200.20).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make appropriations from revenue receipts in excess of those budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Department of Recreation, Parks and Tourism has received unanticipated revenue from Salisbury Scrap Metal, Inc., in the amount of Five Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$5,925.20), for recycling old metal bleachers at Arthur W. Perdue Stadium, as well as unanticipated revenue from 7th Inning Stretch, LP, in the amount of Four Thousand, Two Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$4,275), for selling old seats at the Arthur W. Perdue Stadium; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism desires that said revenue be allocated among the account specified below; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wicomico County Council that the following appropriations of funds are authorized and approved:


