Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT UNANTICIPATED REVENUE, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000), FOR AN INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE PAID OUT IN FISCAL YEAR 16 THAT WAS REIMBURSED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TRUST, AND TO APPROPRIATE THE MONEY TO THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE.

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make appropriations from revenue receipts in excess of those budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Department of Corrections paid an insurance deductible, in the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), during Fiscal Year 2016, on a claim relating to a new chiller that failed as a result of improper installation and start-up by the manufacturer's representative and vendor; and

WHEREAS, the County's insurance carrier, Local Government Insurance Trust (LGIT), recently recovered said insurance deductible and has refunded the money to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections has requested that the funds be returned to the County's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wicomico County Council that the following appropriation of funds is authorized and approved:


