Wor-Wic Community College-Local Advisory Council Nominee

Mr. Cannon said this was a request that came in from Dr. Ray Hoy, President, Wor-Wic Community College. He is requesting a nominee from Council for the Local Advisory Council. He asked is this nominee for a Council member, or a citizen of Wicomico County, to which Mrs. Hurley clarified, it is a citizen.

Mr. Kilmer asked if this was something the Executive Office appoints and the Council confirms, to which Mr. Strausburg said, they went back and looked at the underlying foundational documents, and this is one that is different than the typical process. He said he does not know if it is something that was not addressed when they had the change in the form of government or what. Mr. Culver said it was prior to the Executive form of government. Mr. Strausburg said it appears to be a holdover. Mr. Cannon said it would be a formality, as it is not going to make a big difference, but he would suggest to the Local Advisory Council to update their documents. Mr. Cannon asked if there were any suggestions of how they would like to fill this position. Mr. Kilmer said if any Council members were interested, he said they should work with the Executive's Office on this. Mr. Strausburg said they would work collectively. Mr. Kilmer said he is not sure how they solicit people to serve generally. Mr. Cannon said in the elected school board committee they were looking for people from different avenues, there is no defined fields here.

Mr. Davis said maybe someone from the business community. Mr. Cannon said he would defer to the Chamber of Commerce, and ask the local Chamber of Commerce who they would like to see fill this position, maybe the new CEO would want to take on that call. Mr. Cannon said he would pursue this with the Chamber and see what they want to do.
