A RESOLUTION TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE RECREATION AND PARKS DIVISION FROM UNANTICIPATED REVENUE RECEIVED FROM GOVDEALS INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND THIRTEEN CENTS (\$18,745.13)

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make appropriations from revenue receipts in excess of those budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation and Parks Division has received unanticipated revenue from Gov Deals, in the amount of Eighteen Thousand, Seven Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$18,745.13) that represents the proceeds from the sale of the lights and poles that were removed from the old soccer fields at the Henry S. Parker Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation and Parks Division has requested that the unanticipated revenue be added to the current Henry S. Parker renovation project to allow for additional improvements to that project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the following appropriation of funds is authorized and approved:
