A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES-PROGRAM OPEN SPACE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND, FIFTY DOLLARS (\$175,050), TO BE USED FOR THE HENRY S. PARKER ATHLETIC COMPLEX FIELD EXPANSION.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources through Program Open Space administers funds made available to local communities for open and recreational areas; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism is expanding the Henry S. Parker Complex; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism submitted an application for Program Open Space funds and has been awarded a grant in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand, Fifty Dollars (\$175,050), with a 10% required local funding match, to help offset the cost of the Henry S. Parker Athletic Complex Field Expansion; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant award from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources-Program Open Space; and


WHEREAS, the grant funds will be placed in Fund 02, State Grants, Project No. 14129, Expansion of Athletic Fields.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources-Program Open Space in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand, Fifty Dollars (\$175,050).


