Resolution No. 123-2017

Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$97,185), FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Circuit Rider Program; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Planning (MDP) Lower Eastern Shore Regional staff has submitted a grant application to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development on behalf of the Towns of Sharptown, Pittsville and Willards, and has been awarded grant funds in the amount of Ninety-Seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$97,185); and

WHEREAS, the Circuit Rider individual will work for a period of two years with the goal of; (1) providing assistance with the day-to-day planning operations and related questions from the public; (2) researching various federal and State grant opportunities that align with desired planning and infrastructure projects; (3) developing grant applications and managing grant awards; (4) overseeing special projects assigned by the Towns of Sharptown, Pittsville and Willards and (5) providing an enhanced level of administrative capacity to the Towns of Sharptown, Pittsville and Willards; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends accepting the grant funds in the amount of Ninety-Seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (97,185).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate grant funds, in the amount of Ninety-Seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$97,185), from the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development.
2. The grant funds shall be used for a Circuit Rider individual to assist the Towns of Sharptown, Pittsville and Willards for a period of two years.
3. The County Executive is to establish a grant project number under State Grant Fund 02, upon acceptance of the grant award.




