A RESOLUTION APPROVING THOMAS J. MACE, ESQUIRE, SANDRA K. MARTIN, AND M. DOUGLAS RAYFIELD AS NOMINEES TO BE SENT TO THE GOVERNOR, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW, TO BE CONSIDERED FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT APPEAL BOARD.

WHEREAS, Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Section 3-102, provides for a Property Tax Assessment Appeal Board in Wicomico County; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-103 of the Tax-Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires the County Council approve the nominees recommended by the County Executive for submission to the Governor; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed the following individuals as nominees to be submitted to the Governor for consideration for appointment to the Property Tax Assessment Appeal Board: (1) Thomas J. Mace, Esquire to serve as a regular member, (2) Sandra K. Martin to serve as an alternate member, and (3) M. Douglas Rayfield to serve as a regular member and Chair; and

WHEREAS, the County Council ratifies the County Executive's special trust and confidence in the abilities of the nominees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the names of Thomas J. Mace, Esquire, Sandra K. Martin and M. Douglas Rayfield as nominees are approved for submission to the Governor for consideration for appointment to the Property Tax Assessment Appeal Board.
