A RESOLUTION TO INITIATE THE CREATION OF AN URBAN SERVICE DISTRICT FOR STREET LIGHTING IN THE KELVINGTON AND HEARN & BAILEY FARM SUBDIVISIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 97, Section 97-4 (B), of the Wicomico County Code, property owners in the Kelvington and Hearn & Bailey Farm Subdivisions have petitioned the Wicomico County Urban Services Commission to establish an urban service district to provide street lighting; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Services Commission desires to have a preliminary engineering survey prepared to determine the feasibility and probable cost of providing the Kelvington and Hearn & Bailey Farm Subdivisions with the street lighting service requested in said petition; and


WHEREAS, the Urban Services Commission desires to prepare an estimate of the costs of making surveys and preparing a complete engineering and financial report for the Kelvington and Hearn & Bailey Farm street lighting project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wicomico County Urban Services Commission that the process to initiate the creation of an urban services district for street lighting in the Kelvington and Hearn & Bailey Farm Subdivisions, including the preparation of a preliminary engineering survey and cost estimate for making surveys and preparing a complete engineering and financial report, is hereby approved.


