A RESOLUTION TO DETERMINE THE URBAN SERVICES BILLING FOR SEWER USAGE AT 615 IRENE AVENUE, SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the Urban Services Commission on February 20, 2018 adopted Resolution 03-2018 establishing an Urban Services Commission Policy on Non-Beneficial Use of Water; and

WHEREAS, the County Finance Department has received a request from the property owner of 615 Irene Avenue, Salisbury, MD for relief of a quarterly sewer bill for the period of January 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the quarterly sewer bill is unusually high due to an automatic watering meter on an outside water spigot that was broken; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Services Commission Policy on Non-Beneficial Use of Water indicates that relief can be granted only for non-beneficial use of water; and


WHEREAS, the property owners have submitted an appeal letter to the Urban Services Commission requesting relief of the quarterly sewer bill for the period of January 1, 2018 through March 31, 2018 as the use of water was not a beneficial use during the winter months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wicomico County Urban Services Commission that the request submitted by Susan Weisengoff Patt for relief of the sewer bill in the first quarter of 2018 (January 1, 2018-March 31, 2018) at the location of 615 Irene Avenue, Salisbury, MD is hereby ~~TO BE DETERMINED BY THE URBAN SERVICES COMMISSION~~ AS NON-BENEFICIAL USE OF WATER.
