A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING PERSONS FOR TRAINING UNDER THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-213 of the General Provisions Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, each public body shall designate at least one individual who is an employee, an officer, or a member of the public body to receive training on the requirements of the open meetings law; and

WHEREAS, effective October 1, 2017, a public body may not meet in closed session unless a member has been designated to take the training; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Council desires to designate the persons listed on the attached Exhibit A to receive training on the requirements of the open meetings law; and

WHEREAS, training is to be completed within 90 days after being designated. (Training taken after October 1, 2013 satisfies the requirement).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the persons listed on the attached Exhibit A are hereby designated to receive training on the Open Meetings Act.
