**Resolution No. 104-2020**

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DATE FOR VOTING ON LEGISLATIVE BILL 2020-09.

WHEREAS, Legislative Bill 2020-09 proposes to prohibit unauthorized salary increases, and establish penalties, removal and liability provisions; and

WHEREAS, Section 311 of the Charter of Wicomico County, Maryland provides that all legislation not passed within sixty (60) days after its introduction shall fail, unless five (5) members of Council affirmatively vote to extend this deadline; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Bill 2020-09 was introduced on August 18, 2020 and will fail if not acted upon by October 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to request by the Acting County Executive, the County Council has determined that additional time is needed to review and consider the proposed provisions to be included in Chapter 59 of the County Code, titled "Personnel Rules"; and

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to extend the drop-dead date to vote on Legislative Bill 2020-09 to November 17, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the date for voting on Legislative Bill 2020-09, to prohibit unauthorized salary increases and establish penalties, removal and liability provisions in Chapter 59 of the Wicomico County Code, titled "Personnel Rules" is hereby extended to November 17, 2020.
