A RESOLUTION TO DEDICATE THE FUTURE PIRATE’S WHARF BOAT RAMP
IN THE MEMORY OF BOB CULVER

WHEREAS, the late Bob Culver was born on October 20, 1952 in Wicomico County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Bob entered into politics in 2010 and served one term on the Wicomico County Council before being elected Wicomico County Executive in 2014, and reelected to a second term in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the late Bob Culver had many accomplishments as County Executive, one of which is the vision to develop 340 acres along the Wicomico River into a park to be named "Pirate’s Wharf"; and

WHEREAS, the future Pirate’s Wharf park will include a trail system, public gathering space as well as a public boat ramp for access to the water; and

WHEREAS, the late Bob Culver took an active role in moving the Pirate’s Wharf Park project forward by securing a federal grant award of \$820,000 from the National Park Service through the Land and Water Conservation Fund for the development of the property; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and Acting County Executive recognize and appreciate the devotion and persistent efforts of the late Bob Culver in developing the future Pirate’s Wharf Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the future Pirate’s Wharf boat ramp shall be dedicated to the late Bob Culver and a permanent plaque be mounted on the boat ramp in his honor.
