A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION, PARKS & TOURISM IN THE AMOUNT OF NINE THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$9,800).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the county budget; and

WHEREAS, an economic impact and improvement feasibility study is being undertaken by the Maryland Stadium Authority to determine the feasibility of increasing revenues at Arthur W. Perdue Stadium; and

WHEREAS, as part of the feasibility study, a request has been made for an engineering assessment on the stadium's structural integrity; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism has requested funding in the amount of \$9,800 to have the engineering assessment performed; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.




