A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY TO ACQUIRE AN EASEMENT OVER CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND LOCATED ALONG AND BINDING COLLEGE AVENUE AND BEAGLIN PARK DRIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A SIDEWALK.

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Safe Routes to School Program (SRTS) provides funding to local communities to make biking and walking to school safer and to encourage students to adopt this method of traveling to and from school; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works submitted a SRTS Grant Application and has been awarded funding for the construction of a sidewalk along College Avenue and Beaglin Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works now desires to obtain an easement over certain parcels of land located along and binding College Avenue and Beaglin Park Drive for the purpose of constructing said sidewalk; and


WHEREAS, the construction of the sidewalk along College Avenue and Beaglin Park Drive is dependant upon the acquisition of the easements; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has held a public hearing, following due notice, on the proposed sidewalk easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to acquire an easement over those certain parcels of land located along and binding College Avenue and Beaglin Park Drive as described in the public notice, attached as Exhibit "A", for the construction of a sidewalk that will provide a safe route for students commuting to and from local area schools.
