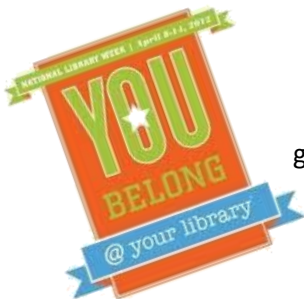
MISSION: To serve the people of Wicomico County by supporting education, enriching lives, and building community.

DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW OF FUNCTIONS:

Through the Library's multiple locations, citizens in Wicomico County enjoy access to a large physical collection of books, music, movies, magazines and other materials. They can have them delivered and returned to any of the library's locations or the bookmobile. The Library hours of operation have at least one location open every day of the week. Trained Library staff offer assistance in finding, selecting and using information.

- Enjoy 24/7 access to a wide variety of online resources including subscription databases, eBooks and downloadable audio books
 - 135,304 books covering a wide range of interest areas, topics, reading levels and languages
 - 7,466 audiobook and music CD's
 - 11,354 movies and video games
 - 120 magazine and newspaper subscriptions
- Take advantage of the Library's meeting spaces for community groups
 - 6 public meeting rooms
- Enjoy free access to public computers and WiFi access
 - 90 public computers
 - 5 early literacy computers designed to stimulate a young child's imagination and teach basic computer skills
 - Printers, copiers and a microfilm reader
- Attend any of the over 940 free library events and classes
- Utilize the Library's website as an access point for public services including governmental, non-profit, education and community agencies

Where is the Library located?

- *Main Library* - located downtown Salisbury at the intersection of Division and Market Streets
- *Pittsville Branch* – located on the campus of the Pittsville Elementary & Middle School
- *Centre Branch* – located across from Chuck E. Cheese's

Where does the Library funding come from?

The Wicomico Public Library is funded primarily from County and State revenues. Some additional funding comes from fees, fines and the sale of used books as well as donations from citizens and grants programs.



WICOMICO PUBLIC LIBRARY QUICK FACTS:

- There are more public libraries in the United States than there are McDonalds
- Each year the Wicomico Public Library lends over 650,000 items
- Over 55% of the population of Wicomico County has a Library card
- If you need a book we do not have in our library, we can borrow it from another library on the Eastern Shore, in Maryland, or even from elsewhere in the United States
- There are nearly 2000 library items on loan at any given time
