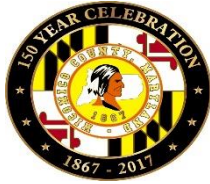

## WHAT DOES “KNOW YOUR ZONE” MEAN?

Tiered evacuation zones were developed in close coordination with local emergency managers throughout those high-risk areas based on the most up-to-date engineering data for Wicomico County dealing with **Storm Surge/Tidal Flooding**.

Zones are designated A through C. They provide residents with clarity on whether they should evacuate in an emergency or shelter at home, based on their physical street address and the nature of the emergency event. When a serious storm is expected to threaten or impact the County Department of Emergency Services will work with local news media outlets that will then broadcast and publish evacuation directives to the public.

Residents not residing in a pre-identified evacuation area should listen to local evacuation orders from local and state emergency agencies to determine if and when to evacuate.
