Bill No. 2019-05 (EMERGENCY)

Introduced by: The President of the Council

AN ACT TO AMEND THE WICOMICO COUNTY CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN BY ADDING POSITIONS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, to effectively administer County personnel, the Wicomico County Classification and Pay Plan has standardized titles and common job language; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Sheriff ~~recommends the addition of three positions to provide the County with additional law enforcement capability.~~ HAS ADVISED THAT THE ILLEGAL DISTRIBUTION OF OPIOID AND OTHER DANGEROUS DRUGS AND COMPOUNDS IN THE COUNTY CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY AFFECTING THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF COUNTY RESIDENTS IN A MANNER THAT IS BOTH SUDDEN AND UNEXPECTED AND RECOMMENDS THE IMMEDIATE ADDITION OF THREE POSITIONS TO PROVIDE THE COUNTY WITH ADDITIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT CAPABILITY TO MORE EFFECTIVELY RESPOND TO THIS EMERGENCY;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN RELIANCE UPON THE ADVICE AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE SHERIFF, BY THE REQUIRED VOTE OF AT LEAST FIVE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO ENACT THIS LEGISLATION AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE;

SECTION I. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION, that the Wicomico County Classification and Pay Plan is amended as follows AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AFFECTING THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE IN A MATTER WHICH HAS SUDDENLY AND UNEXPECTEDLY ARISEN WHICH REQUIRES IMMEDIATE ACTION IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST;

The following positions are added to the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office:

- A. 2 Deputy First Class positions.
- B. 1 Corporal position.

SECTION II. IT IS HEREBY DECLARED FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECTION 311.G OF THE CHARTER THAT THE EMERGENCY DESCRIBED BY THE SHERIFF, AS STATED ABOVE, EXISTS.

~~**SECTION III.**~~ Be it Further Enacted, that this Bill will not be codified in the Wicomico County Code.

~~**SECTION III IV.**~~ BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT this Bill will be known as Bill No. 2019-05 of Wicomico County, Maryland, and will ~~take effect~~ BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS FINAL PASSAGE. 60 days after its final passage, unless a Petition for Referendum is filed before then. If a timely Petition FOR REFERENDUM is filed, the Bill SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE, BUT SHALL STAND REPEALED THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER REJECTION BY will not take effect until the expiration of 30 days following the approval of this Bill by a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in a referendum.


